Edgenuity replaces Gradpoint as online instructional platform

December 17, 2020, marked the end of Gradpoint curriculum at CPCHS. Since August, students have been transitioning from Gradpoint into Edgenuity courses. According to Edgenuity's website, "Our courses feature rigorous, standards-based instruction; powerful interactive tools that support learning; and engaging multimedia and real-world applications that help ensure students build content knowledge and essential skills." Students enrolled at CPCHS have the added benefit of certified teachers and support staff to assist them as they navigate the courses.

To be eligible for enrollment, a student must be 14-20 years of age, must have been a ninth grader at one time, and must have completed all dispositions from another school. Credit Recovery students may attend for \$150 per class.
