	Step 3:	Grade Point Average Requirement Click on the words Welcome (Your Name) On the left you will see "My HOPE GPA" Most USG schools require you to have a core GPA of 3.0 in order to participate in the Dual Enrollment program. Your HOPE GPA is a great indicator of this average.
	Step 4:	Complete Online application through GaFutures Click on College Planning section and select Applications and Transcripts Choose the "Apply to College" tab and select the Georgia University of your choice. Scroll to the bottom of the page to "Begin or Continue Application" During the application process, please make sure you indicate that you are a Dual Enrollment student. There is NO application fee for this program. Each Technical College has their own application. Please go to their website to access the application. Some may not have the application online. Please contact the Technical College that you plan to attend for a paper application.
	Step 5:	Transcript Request. Click on the College Planning section and select Applications and Transcripts.(Some Technical Colleges do not require a transcript - please contact the Technical College you plan to attend.) Choose the "Request Your Transcripts" tab. On the left you will see "My Transcript". Request to have your transcript sent to Georgia University of your choice and be sure to include your social security number and accept the Terms of Use and Private Policy agreement. This request will be automatically sent to the Coastal Plains District Registrar. If your transcript is not available in GaFutures, please see your counselor. Fall Term - Have this completed by May 1st of the previous year. Spring Term - Have this completed by November 1st. Summer Term - Have this completed by April 30th. Coastal Plains CEEB code - 110099
